

**CA Regional CGA Committee Minutes  
Virtual Meeting  
February 18, 2021**

**Objective:**

The primary mission of California Regional Common Ground Alliance (CARCGA) is to eliminate safety risks to life, health, and property while also preventing damage to underground infrastructure and vital public services.

CARCGA will accomplish this mission by: encouraging stakeholders to accept and fulfill their shared responsibility in damage prevention; welcoming all stakeholders within California and encouraging their participation in CARCGA; educating members and non-members regarding Common Ground Alliance Best Practices; identifying issues concerning damage prevention and attempting to construct practices to resolve them; exchanging ideas and information with other CGA Regional Partners.

When a new damage prevention practice is created, CARCGA may forward the practice on to the CGA Best Practices Committee for their consideration. CARCGA's efforts in damage prevention will help eliminate damages to underground infrastructure, interruption to vital services, safety risks, accidents, and fatalities.

When citing examples of incidents, please refer to the parties involved anonymously.

**1. Call to Order:**

Marshall Johnson called the meeting to order at 9:36 a.m. and read the objective.

**2. Attendance – See sign in sheet at end**

**3. Review Minutes from Previous Meeting**

Marshall asked for a motion to approve the minutes that had been previously emailed. Russel Guidry moved to accept the minutes and Dorothy Bergman seconded. Hearing no objections, the minutes were approved as emailed.

**4. Dig Safe Board Update**

Dig Safe Board Chair, Marjorie Del Toro told the group that the meetings for 2021 are posted and are scheduled for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday and Tuesday of each month but will probably only be on Tuesdays. She said that in 2020 the Board had received 60 applications from Regional Notification Center members requesting a one-year extension for the electronic positive response requirement. 3 withdrew their application when they realized they would be able to comply by January 1, 2021. Also, in 2020 the Board completed 130 investigations with 25 to 30 still active. They expect to have them come before the board starting in April as notices of probable violations. The Board heard their first cases in September and November and had 12 recommendations to the CPUC and CSLB that the violators take the Dig Safe Boards education course. Investigative staff also issued four advisory letters. Based on those enforcement actions the federal Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) deemed California adequate in its enforcement of 4216. **5. CGA Update**

Ann Diamond said that registration for the CGA Conference in October in Florida is open. She noted that CGA committee meetings were being held virtual the first week of March. She said that DIRT data for 2020 needs to be input by March 31<sup>st</sup> for inclusion in the report. She also

said that she still has some Best Practices Books for anyone who would like the limited supply. Thomas Young said that the webinar that the CARCGA Technology committee presented on GIS was being held again for the CGA Technology committee on March 4<sup>th</sup>.

## **6. Notification Center Updates**

James Wingate from USA North 811 reported that the center's ticket volume in 2020 was down from 2019 and January 2021 was down 21% from January 2020. He said that the center is doing some internal shifting of staff. He said that their speed of answer is at a good level. He said they added another person to member services as less than 60% of members have updated their information and moved another damage prevention specialist that had been doing some video work to education and marketing full time.

Ann Diamond said her predication in December that DigAlert would end the year with about a 4% increase was close. The center had a 3.81% increase. 2020 ended with 65.5% web usage. She did note that January 2021 had a 10% decrease over January 2020, but it could be because there were 2 fewer workdays in January 2021. So far in February the trend is creeping up. She said that DigAlert was celebrating 45 years of service on September 13<sup>th</sup>. Randy Charland asked if that meant the center was giving out \$4,500. Ann said no but maybe the 20 million ticket would be taken around the anniversary. She said the big celebration will be in 5 years for the center's 50<sup>th</sup>.

Marshall Johnson asked the centers if they are tracking how many times excavators are checking the EPR status portal. Both James and Ann said that the center sends email and or text messages with the responses as of the legal start date and time but don't know if there is tracking of the website views. Marshall also asked how the excavators like the system. James said that so far only positive feedback from excavators on the system but those tend to be the good excavators. He did say that the use of codes for not marking had some feedback from excavators.

Randy Charland asked about COVID-19 vaccines and tiers for utilities. James said that he had been contacted by another contract locating company wanting USA North 811 to write a letter designating utility locators as essential personnel. James said he can provide a generic letter to contract or in-house locators that they are essential workers for the purpose of getting the vaccine.

## **7. Committee Reports**

### **A. Board of Directors Update**

Marshall Johnson said the Board met and are still discussing the options for trademarking the logo. He said that a letter was sent to the Dig Safe Board asking for their opinion on what a "new installation" is in the recently added section of 4216 as well as asking them to take over the damage reporting now that they are receiving all damages and doing investigations. He said CARCGA would provide the CA DIRT data to them too. These items will be put into the idea registry for the Dig Safe Board. He thanked the stakeholder members that paid in December and January. He said there are 6 stakeholder members that haven't yet paid their dues for 2021. He went over the financials from December and January that leaves a balance of \$20,633.23. Gilbert Aceves motioned to accept the financials as presented. Anthony Headley seconded. The motion carried.

### **B. Subsurface Safety and Incident Prevention Committee Update.**

Steve Woo reported that the committee had come to consensus on recommendations for private facility markings. *(Those recommendations are in the document 2021 SSIP*

*Recommendations – Private Facility Marking attached*). He said that the committee had agreed on the next topics for discussion – abuse of emergency declarations, locate mark removals, competent jurisdiction and shallow depth damages liabilities if facilities aren't at the minimum required depth. Randy Charland asked if others within a company can join the committee discussion especially if they have more information about a topic. Steve and Thomas Young said they have invited others with expertise to meetings and welcome anyone with knowledge on the subject to join. Thomas reminded those on the committee to be sure to review the information sent to be ready for active discussions on the subject. The committee meets the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of every month starting at 9:30am.

**C. Education Programs and Marketing Committee Update.**

Michael Worster said that the committee had been meeting a few times to set up the Electronic Positive Response (EPR) Webinar that will be held on February 19, 2021. The webinar is targeted to those operators that have not started using EPR. He said it will be posted to the CARCGA You Tube site. He said that at the next committee meeting they are going to do planning and get the heartbeat of the industry. Marshall Johnson asked what's next for the marketing committee as far as webinars. Michael said that a more formal marketing research might be needed to determine what topic should be covered. Marshall asked if the committee had partnered with the Dig Safe Board or CSLB or other groups. The committee meets the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of every month from 10 to 11am.

**D. Legislative and Regulatory Committee Update.**

Ann Diamond said the committee has begun to meet monthly and had originally thought 4216 wasn't going to be opened this year but SB 297 has been proposed. The bill basically increases the civil penalty to \$100,000 if an excavator doesn't notify a gas corporation or wait for them to mark their lines and their license could be revoked. She said that the committee has been talking about items in 4216 that could use clarification or updating like requiring delineation and operators not given the option that they could mark without delineation, vacuum excavation steps, definitions of "in conflict with the excavation" and reasonable care, damage notifications when it's the operators own line they discover a damage, changing 4216.7 from approximate location to tolerance zone and wanting to remove the CalTrans exemption. She said that nothing is finalized, and the committee meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month from 1 to 2:30pm.

Marshall Johnson said that when asking people to participate in committee meetings that CARCGA is looking for people to be involved not just for the one topic but for all of damage prevention to make excavating as safe as possible. Not just one and done participation, he wants people to stay involved.

**9. New Business**

**A. Marking Newly Installed Lines**

Dorothy Bergman said that Edison is responding to a notice of violation. She said that in 2017 an excavator called in a ticket and Edison marked their lines. Shortly after that Edison installed and energized a new 16kv conductor. The excavator then began their excavation, came across the unmarked line and unfortunately cut through it and an employee was injured. She said that they received a large citation due to that event. She said that Edison is now using the DigAlert app to find any active tickets when their crews are installing new lines. If there are active tickets, they are working on a process to notify

their locator to come out and mark the new line and contact the excavator to let them know of its existence. She asked the group how they handle the time between installing a new line and getting that information back to the locating group and notification center. Ann Diamond asked how long it usually takes to get the information to the notification center. Gilbert Aceves said that it can take a few weeks. The group discussed the various ways their companies mark newly installed lines in areas where excavation is ongoing. The main challenge seems to be getting the maps to the locating group when a new ticket is established after the line is installed. Steve Woo said that the issue could be brought to the SSIP committee for discussion. Dorothy asked James Wingate about their app and if they would have a similar way to find active tickets. James said there are other options to get the information Dorothy is requesting. Marshall Johnson said that he thought that USA North 811 had mentioned they would have something similar to the functionality of the app that could find active tickets. James said that he would have to follow up with the status of having access to searching for active tickets, but it wouldn't be a native app but a portal to a website.
