

**CA Regional CGA Committee Minutes  
Virtual Meeting  
October 15, 2020**

**Objective:**

The primary mission of California Regional Common Ground Alliance (CARCGA) is to eliminate safety risks to life, health, and property while also preventing damage to underground infrastructure and vital public services.

CARCGA will accomplish this mission by: encouraging stakeholders to accept and fulfill their shared responsibility in damage prevention; welcoming all stakeholders within California and encouraging their participation in CARCGA; educating members and non-members regarding Common Ground Alliance Best Practices; identifying issues concerning damage prevention and attempting to construct practices to resolve them; exchanging ideas and information with other CGA Regional Partners.

When a new damage prevention practice is created, CARCGA may forward the practice on to the CGA Best Practices Committee for their consideration. CARCGA's efforts in damage prevention will help eliminate damages to underground infrastructure, interruption to vital services, safety risks, accidents and fatalities.

When citing examples of incidents, please refer to the parties involved anonymously.

**1. Call to Order:**

Marshall Johnson called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. and read the objective.

**2. Attendance – See sign in sheet at end**

**3. Review Minutes from Previous Meeting**

Marshall asked for a motion to approve the minutes that had been previously emailed. Gilbert Aceves moved to accept the minutes and Pete Cerda seconded. Hearing no objections, the minutes were approved as emailed.

**4. Dig Safe Board Update**

Executive Officer Tony Marino said that the next Dig Safe Board meeting would be in November. He said that at the September meeting the 13 notices of probable violation (NOPV) were recommended for education. He said the education module is changing from in person to a virtual platform and the investigators will be teaching the course. He said another workshop on reasonable care standards for trenchless excavations would be held on October 29<sup>th</sup> and he encouraged excavators to join in the discussion. He reported that there had been about 50 extensions for Electronic Positive Response submitted by the deadline of October 1<sup>st</sup>. He reminded everyone that the idea register would be used to help shape the Boards 2021 planning and while the ideas for 2021 needed to be input by October 16<sup>th</sup> submissions can be done at any time. Gilbert Aceves asked how long the education would be and Tony responded about 5 hours. Bob Carpenter thanked the Dig Safe Board for pushing to get the hand tool exception passed. Tony noted that it was effective on September 18<sup>th</sup>. Sunil Shori asked if those operators that did not get an extension and still don't do EPR would have some sort of action from the Dig Safe Board. Tony said that they are working on a standardized letter. For agendas, documents and regulations go to the Dig Safe Board website at <https://digsafe.fire.ca.gov/>.

**5. CGA Update**

Ann Diamond said that she still has a limited number of Best Practices booklets. Anyone who wants one should let her know. The November committee meetings will be virtual, but they are still planning on the March Conference in Florida to be in person. She said that the National DIRT report was released yesterday and the CARCGA report would be completed soon.

## **6. Notification Center Updates**

Ann Diamond said that DigAlert still has everyone working from home. She said at the August meeting she had said that in July the center took the most tickets in the center's history, but August and September were not too far behind. She said that the center took its 19 millionth ticket on October 8, 14 months after the 18<sup>th</sup> millionth. Almost 1 million tickets in a year during a pandemic. She said that on many days the web NEW tickets are more than the center's new tickets. Through the end of September, the center had almost a 5% increase over the same time in 2019 and web tickets are about 65%.

James Wingate from USA North 811 reported that ticket volume had increased about 4%. About 80% of tickets are done online. The center's lease was up and instead of moving they gave back a portion of their suite to downsize and modernize the area they kept. He noted that the center had some personnel contract COVID but were recovering.

Marshall Johnson asked the centers what was being done about fire restoration projects. Sunil Shori also asked about tickets for the same locations. James said that each excavator needs their own ticket even if the location is the same and that there weren't any changes planned at this time. Marshall said there are times when fires are occurring that air quality issues, evacuation orders and such make it impossible to respond to tickets. Anthony Headley noted that authorities do have the right to refuse entrance and that everyone should be aware of the current situations in an area.

## **7. Committee Reports**

### **A. Board of Directors Update**

Marshall Johnson said the Board is looking at different virtual platforms to determine what might work best for the group. The financials showed a current balance of \$18,645.63. Randy Charland moved to accept the financials as presented and Colette Shelly seconded. The motion carried.

### **B. Subsurface Safety and Incident Prevention Committee Update.**

Steve Woo reported that the committee had continued discussions on private mark-outs. He said that there is general agreement to use the APWA colors to identify the different facility types, and the group is still trying to agree on how to differentiate when private locates begin and marks placed by the operator end. The committee generally meets the first Tuesday of each month. If you want to join the committee send your request to [ssip@carcga.org](mailto:ssip@carcga.org).

### **C. Education Programs and Marketing Committee Update.**

Michael Worster said the committee has a new co-chair – Collin Miyadi. He said a newsletter would be coming out soon and it will include current events outside of CARCGA. He asked for members to provide specific topics to include in future editions. He said in person events were on hold due to COVID. Marshall asked if any virtual events had been planned. Michael said if anyone is doing this type of event and thinks a partnership with CARCGA would work to please contact [education@carcga.org](mailto:education@carcga.org)

**D. Legislative and Regulatory Committee Update.**

Ann Diamond said in the packet she had included new Title 19 Regulations and the changes to 4216. There were questions about who to contact for damages, use of clay spades, soil classification, GIS, embedded lines and liability. It was suggested to seek an interpretation from the Dig Safe Board or check with your own legal departments.

**E. Technology Committee Update.**

Thomas Young said the committee was setting up a webinar to explain what GIS terms are and the new 4216 GIS requirement for November 13<sup>th</sup> at 10am. He thanked Aaron Rezendez for reaching out to CAL GIS to assist with the webinar. Sunil added that resources and providing clarity on what GIS is will be the focus of the webinar.

**8. Old Business**

**A. Nominations Open for Stakeholder Members – Engineering, Locator, Oil, Telecommunication, Sewer and State Regulator**

Today is the last day for nominations in engineering, locator, oil, telecommunication, sewer and state regulator industry types for Stakeholder members. At this time there have been no nominations for any of the openings which means the current directors will remain as the Stakeholder representative.

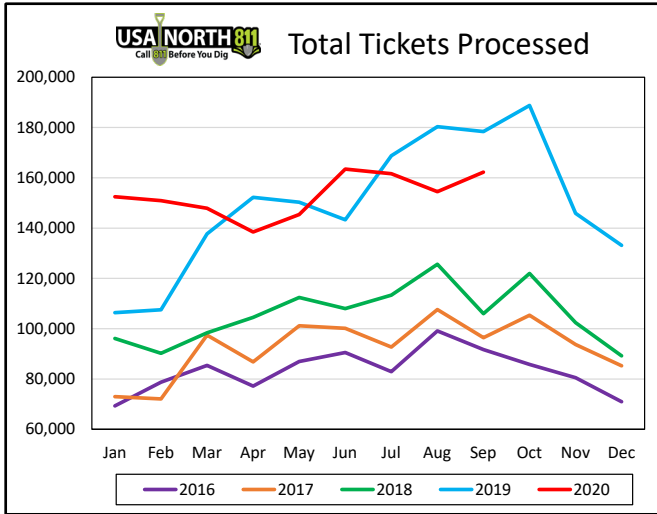

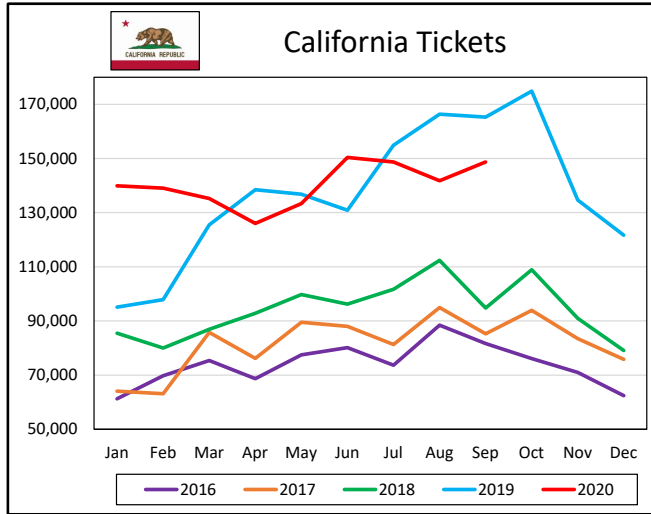

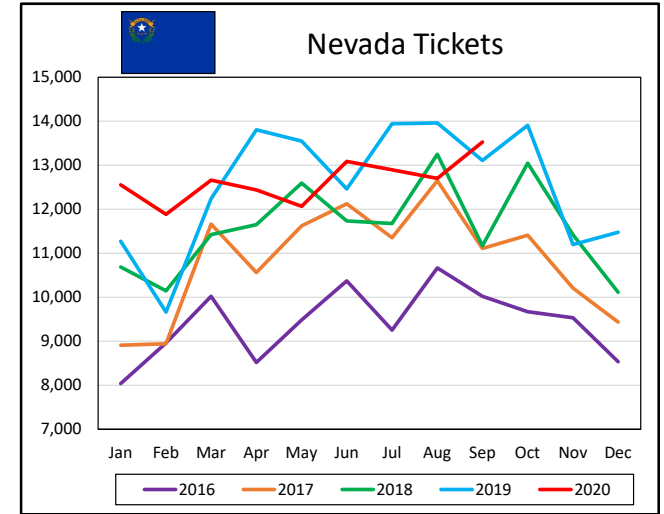
